### OUR FUTURE

In the next few months, there will be several issues on our plate that we will  
be addressing:

- 1) I continue my "battle" against the Left's push to get our local governments  
to bring Public Access Television (PATV) to Gainesville. It's a complex  
issue but it's characterized by the taking of cable company's property,  
taxation to support it, unfettered access regardless of merit or quality, and  
"theft" of our speech.
- 2) We voted to initiate an amendment to the county charter adding "None of  
the Above" (NOTA) as a candidate for every local elected position.
- 3) We voted to participate and support a marijuana deprioritization  
amendment that is being promoted by a new Political Action Committee  
called "Gainesville for Practical Law Enforcement".
- 4) We will speak-out against the campaign finance reform amendment that  
will be on this fall's ballot and which will limit donations to candidates  
to \$250/person. - and we'd like to field Libertarian candidates. - and more!
